




## Mission: to advance yoga therapy as a recognized health profession

Accreditation of yoga therapy education, which is dedicated to expanding the education to accommodate the growth of the practice scope




## Purpose of Individual Certification?



- Recognition of yoga therapists who meet or exceed an established set of standards
- Quality-control mechanism whereby a public stamp of approval is given to highly trained yoga therapists through a credible, objective, peerreview process



### **IAYT Certification Milestones**




### **IAYT Certification Exam**


Sets standards for the profession of yoga therapy and protects the public by ensuring that certified individuals have met predetermined criteria for safe practice
